



The core learning of the GIFT program is conducted online through our exclusive curriculum and Learning Management System (LMS). GIFT Fellows will complete the online coursework to obtain their FAFS credential upon graduation.

A pivotal part of the GIFT journey is participation in the Learning Opportunities (LOPs). These are strategically structured within the curriculum to complement the online education experience and ensure understanding and application of the content. Therefore, completion of at least 80% of the LOPs is required for successful completion of GIFT and becoming credentialed as a FAFS.

The LOPs are structured in different ways depending on the educational goals. An appreciation of the individual differences is gained when GIFT Fellows execute and tweak movements and report their body's response to the movement task. At the completion of content on an anatomical region, Fellows are asked to apply their knowledge to Motions, Muscles, and 3D Matrices. These LOPs help the Fellow gain confidence in their acquisition of critical concepts and identify areas needing additional understanding. Virtual Q & A sessions are scheduled at the culmination of each anatomical content emphasis. In addition, Integration webinars are utilized to tie together the anatomical regions to create a deeper appreciation of functional movement. Our Faculty and Facilitators expend great effort to maximize each Fellow's GIFT Journey based on their individual needs.

The final Capstone Learning Experience is a required Case Study Project (CSP). The CSP consists of a short video submission of a patient, client, or athlete. This experience includes a video consultation session with the Dean before submission. Therefore, completion of at least 80% of the videos / web casts and 100% of the LOPs are required for successful completion of GIFT and becoming credentialed as a FAFS.



#### FUNCTIONAL MANUAL REACTION®



Functional Manual Reaction® (FMR) is a training certification described as the application of hands to bone segments in order to facilitate an optimal sequence of motion during a functional movement. FMR is not a passive technique that exists by itself, but rather a technique employed during active movements. FMR is used during the clinical tasks of movement assessment, functional training, and rehabilitation.

FMR is a very powerful and effective tool when utilized during functional movements. However, it cannot be effectively employed without a comprehensive foundation in Applied Functional Science® that includes: three-dimensional joint motion, tri-plane muscle function, biomechanics / kinematics, relative joint motions, and inter-segmental dynamics.

FMR can be used to identify and eliminate impairments to successful movement. It enhances the assessment of movement restrictions caused by muscles and joints. Once the mobility and stability of motion resources are restored, it can be utilized to ensure the proper sequencing of the body's resources that is essential to effective and efficient task execution. FMR can be utilized to facilitate all aspects of the transformation the "loading" motions into the desired "exploding" movement.

Whatever the purpose of the FMR technique, the actual application must be consistent with the principles of function so that the proprioceptive input is genuine. The proprioceptive information (direct by the hands, and indirect through the joint motion and muscle lengthening) must attempt to replicate what the body receives during actual functional activities.

FMR shares some aspects of Proprioceptive Neuromuscular Facilitation (PNF). PNF and FMR emphasize the three-dimensional nature of human movement, the role of hand contact in guiding bone movement, and the potential to increase muscle activation. FMR does not however require specific hand placement for efficacy. FMR, in contrast to PNF, is most commonly used with the client in an upright position so that the load and proprioceptive input produced by gravity are consistent with the functional activity.

The forces applied to bones during FMR are relatively gentle and carry little risk because they are consistent with the physiological movement that is occurring. During the FMR techniques, the hands can be placed on adjacent bones, but also can be placed so that they cross multiple joints. Because of this, FMR is not always specific to a particular joint, but it is always consistent (in each of the three planes) to the Chain Reaction® that occurs during a task-specific global movement selected / designed by the Applied Functional Science® movement professional.

This added tuition would be lumped into your existing / remaining payment plan, paid-in-full, or paid via mutually-agreed upon parameters within a 1-year timeframe.

#### If I take part in the ONLINE option and decide to take part in the gatherings, do I have to do this within the same year?

You do not need to attend the GIFT Gatherings in the same year as your online education. You may only take part in each of the two (2) gatherings once as a GIFT Fellow.

## What if I am unable to attend one (1) or both of the gatherings within the ONLINE + GATHERINGS option?

You may "opt-out" of one (1) or both of the two (2) gatherings. GIFT would need to know this final decision three (3) weeks prior to each of the respective gatherings. Each gathering is valued at \$1,750. Therefore, you would have the option of getting a refund of \$1,750 per gathering or defer your participation to the next year (or beyond).

### Are both gatherings mandatory for Functional Manual Reaction® (FMR) Certification?

Yes. Due to the high standard of certification and the need for hands-on application, both gatherings are required for certification.
